VARIETY PROTECTION :

This variety ripening 3-4 weeks after BERGERON enables to continue the season with the same kind of fruits. Moreover, the agronomic characters at this season are very interesting : productivity, and fruit qualities.

BLOSSOM

Season : late ; 20th of March in 2016 in the Rhone Valley area (France)

Importance of blossom : important

Fertility : SELF FERTILE.

TREE

Growth habit : spreading habit

Vigour : medium to good

Fructification : on each type of branches.

AGRONOMIC CHARACTERS

Productivity : regular and important. Fruits don't drop at maturity

Entrance of production : medium to good

Harvest stage : colour 6 (CTIFL).

FRUIT

Season : very late. 4 weeks after BERGERON ; 5th of August in 2016 in the Rhone Valley area (France)

Size : 3A - 2A

Shape : round

Colour : orange with a light blush

Firmness : very good ; 75 Durofel

Eating quality : good, well balanced (14° Brix)

Cracking tolerance : medium to good

Storage ability : excellent.



Reminder : the numbers (firmness, sugar, size, date, etc..) are indicative ; they strongly depend on the harvest date, the yield and the climatic conditions of the year.
